# **Archery Season Updates**

The 3D Archery season is almost here! During the month of March there will be two workdays to get the 3D archery range in shape for open shoots that start on Tuesday, April 7<sup>th</sup>. The 3D range includes a walking path of slightly less than a mile and 30 foam animal targets set at different distances. There are three sets of stakes set to indicate where the archer should shoot from depending upon the skill level of the individual. The placement of the animals is designed to challenge the archer and provide a simulation of actual hunting situations. Animal targets include north American favorites such as whitetail deer, turkeys and bear, but also include more exotic species such as African lion and hyena.

Competitions on Tuesday are low key and many choose to shoot for fun without a score card. Prizes are based upon the number of shooters present with the most common prize being a pass for a free shoot. Shooters are required to keep score on the honor system as there are no scoring judges. Safety and fun are the key goals on the 3D archery range.

All Tuesday 3D shoots are open to the public and run 5:30pm 'til dark. Additionally the course is open to members every day of the week. Members are requested to place their shooting fee, \$4 per person, in the archery building mail slot. Having the course available during all daylight hours provides a practice opportunity to members hoping to bow hunt or just wanting to launch arrows for the joy of archery.

This year there is a need for some serious maintenance in March prior to the April opening. During the winter a tree fell and took out a shooting platform which dated back 25 years or more (pictures below). March 7<sup>th</sup> and March 14<sup>th</sup> volunteers are needed to build the new platform, clean up other fallen limbs and to pull the targets out of storage and place them around the course.





The workdays are planned to run 8:00-10:00am on these Saturdays but anyone wanting to help outside of these times should contact the club Archery Activity Director, **Larry Murray**, at his Lost Nation Archery number, 269-659-6002.

For any questions about archery here at the club, be sure to contact Larry and he will be glad to help promote the joy of archery.
