COVID-19 Rules for Shotgun Range 5/17/2020

GENERAL TRAP SHOOTING

The St. Joseph County Conservation and Sportsman's Club opened for practice trap shooting Sunday May 17 with shooting staring at 9am as usual. The Club will also be opened on Tuesday evenings at 6pm. There are several changes needed to accommodate the opening of trap and maintain the recommendations by the CDC and following MUCC guidelines regarding the current COVID-19 virus issue.

The clubhouse will remain closed with the exception of the restrooms. The ladies room will be accessed through the building side door near the kitchen. The kitchen is also closed. The outside covered pavilion will be available for shooters use. Masks are strongly recommended while in the clubhouse accessing the restrooms and for volunteer workers that must enter for various reasons. It is also recommended that you leave your gear in your vehicle and access it from there. Persons not of the same household must remain at least 6 feet apart from others while indoors or outdoors.

We will be using tickets rather than tokens for rounds of practice trap, sold in groups of 4 at normal prices per round of 25. Registration/sign up will be through a window on the backside of the clubhouse (the porch area) behind Trap 3. The sign-up line will be "one pass" with an entrance and exit as indicated.

Tickets for each round will be collected/deposited at the scoring chair at the trap house you are assigned to shoot at.

Bring your own hand sanitizer, sanitizing wipes, and masks for your personal use.

ATA SHOOTING

Additional information regarding registered ATA shoots during this COVID-19 declaration include the following:

- Classification, Squadding, and Cashiering will be located at the front of the building facing he parking lot, through separate windows assigned for that purpose.
- Please bring your ATA card (or have your ATA number) and information including current yardage and any declared special category, available. We may ask you for your ATA number to minimize card handling.
- Kitchen may not be available. Bring your own food or snacks. The soda pop vending machine is expected to be available. If the kitchen becomes open (volunteer workers available) food will be distributed through a clubhouse window facing Trap 3. There may be a limited menu. Call for updates on the status of food availability (269-483-6803).
- Bring your own 10x10 pop up cover if you choose, as the clubhouse will probably remain closed except for restroom access. If inclement or sunny weather you may want cover beyond the single outside pavilion or the shaded areas.
