SCTP Team Goes to Nationals



The Club's youth Trap Team, Joseph County SCTP Straight Shooters, sent 13 youth trap athletes to the 2day National Trap Shooting Championship competition held July 17-18 in Marengo Ohio. The team shot at 200 clay targets over the 2 days. There were a total of 1,523 student athletes competing in this 200-target event. Our mixed Varsity/Junior Varsity "Open Division" Squad com-

posed of Luke Carpenter, Carter Bugajski, Price Collins, Bradyn LaRoy, and Adam Baker, placed 14th out of 140 Open Division squads nationally. This placed them in the top 10% of teams in this "mixed" classification division. Our other 2 squads were incomplete having only 4 on a squad (normally 5) and their rankings were understandably lower in this open class. Our Collegiate team, Matt Davis and Taya Bower, placed 13th of 46 college teams with only 2 shooters (vs 5) in the division. **Davis** was our team's top shooter shooting 195/200, which placed him 96/1523 overall (top 6% nationally). Other teammates competing, with many shooting their personal bests, were Emmitt Carpenter, Jovey LaRoy, Kallista Sayer, Vincent Jines, plus Caden Fritts and Carter Royce who just joined our team this year. Price Collins was also new to the team this year. Remaining team members Jaxson Krontz and JP Fritz could not go to Nationals this year.
