## **MI Zone 6 ATA Trap Shoot Results**



The Club successfully ran the 2-day MI Zone 6 ATA shoot on June 6 and 7 at our Club. This was the first 2-day registered trap shoot our Club held in recent history and may be the first time we've ever held a Michigan Zone shoot at the Club. The program for Saturday was 100 Singles Targets, 100 Handicap Targets, and 100 Doubles Targets. Sunday's event was the 200 Championship Singles.

A total of 65 shooters shot over 17,000 targets over the 2 days. We had shooters from Michigan, Indiana, and Ohio. Zone 6 comprises most of lower Southwest Michigan from Berrien to Hillsdale up to Ingham to Allegan counties. The MI Zone 6 200-Singles Winners were (pictured above L to R) Ryan Alberda Class D, Taya Bower Class C, Dennis Doehring Class B, Elliott Alberda Class A, and Jacob Patterson Class AA. These Class trophies were provided by the Michigan Trapshooting Association. Our Club provided other trophies for all events for both Saturday's Class and Yardage winners and Sundays category winners. High All Around was Elliott Alberda. It was the Alberdas (father and son) first time here at our club!

### **Youth SCTP Team Going to Nationals**

The Club's youth Scholastic Clay Target Program (SCTP) St. Joe County Straight Shooters trap team is sending 15 youth to the 2-day Trap Shooting National Championship in Marengo OH July 17-18. The team just recently restarted practices as the Michigan SCTP had halted all practices and competitions due to the virus pandemic. Although Michigan SCTP canceled the SCTP State trap shoot, the National organization has gone forward with its National Championship in the shotgun sports. A separate virtual competition is also offered for those states that have not allowed resumption of group activities.

The MI State SASP (Scholastic Action Shooting Program) rifle and pistol sister program did allow the state shoot in rifle and pistol, which was held at our club in June, but the National SASP organization opted not to compete in person at the National event. However, they are also holding a virtual competition and our youth SASP Sherman Hills Straight Shooters team is participating in that virtual event.
