Winter Trap League Jan 5 to March 15

This year's **Winter Trap League** has been changed up. It will be **SINGLES ON-LY** with the "**OPTION to REGISTER**" your targets as a **Big 50** each week, providing enough people are interested each week. We need 3 to hold a registered event. The trap money league will run for 11-weeks with 10 of the weeks scores to count; 50 targets (2 rounds) each week. We will drop your lowest score if all 11 weeks' scores are shot.

Both registered and non-registered may shoot the league and may shoot on the same squads. Plus open Trap will continue concurrently with these events. We will need at least 3 shooters to shoot registered for the Big 50 to count that week. And you don't have to shoot registered every week. But this option must be decided by the shooter before shooting that week. This is a good way to get your ATA registered targets in. Youth shooters are also very welcome to participate! If enough youth want to participate (minimum 10) we can have a "youth only" category where they will not compete with the adults.

The appropriate reduced fees will apply to those wishing to register their targets with the ATA. The cost will be \$20 for the league pot of money, plus each week's shoot fees (targets), and the ATA & MTA reduced daily fees *if shooting registered for that week*.
