## **Annual Bill Kasdorf ATA Trap Results**



Our second ATA trap shoot for this season was held on Sunday, **April 18**, the "<u>Bill Kasdorf Memorial" Handicap Shoot.</u> This shoot was 3 events composed of 100 Handicaps, 100 Singles, and another 100 Handicap targets.

Once again the High Over Winner was **Glen Rhyner**, from the **Vicksburg Bulldogs High School Trap Team**, but in this case it was the **High Handicap Combined Winner** hitting 179/200 handicap targets. Pictured is Larry York presenting the club trophy that

will add Glen's name to it. Glen also took High Junior trophy in the Singles and first Handicap Events. He place Third in the second Handicap event after winning a shoot off with Dave Harsanyi. Other major winners were **Emmett Carpenter** taking the top Champion spot in the Singles Event, besting all the adults while posting a personal best of 97/100. Emmett is a member of the Conservation Club's youth trap team **Straight Shooters**. The Handicap 1 Champion was **Evan Falk** with a 95/100 and the Handicap 2 Champion was **Emily Brentana** with a 91/100 after winning the shoot off with club member Roger Cook who finished in the Runner Up spot. This was the first time Evan and Emily were at our club. The remaining winners list can be seen on the Club's website under the ATA Trapshooting page of the "Trap, Skeet, 5-Stand" tab. This shoot had 29 shooters from Ohio, Illinois, Indiana, as well as Michigan.

A huge Thank You to all our range helpers, including the scorers and loaders, the registration desk plus our kitchen staff and the guys and gals that set up the grounds beforehand. We could not run these shoots without all of you!

Our remaining ATA shoots this year are Aug 29 and October 10, which is our "**National Trapshooting Day**" leather bag shoot. There is also a few BIG 50 Summer Shoots scheduled for May 16, June 20, July 18, and August 15.

#### St Joe Co Straight Shooters Trap Team & Fund Raiser



Our Club's youth Trap Team, the **St. Joe Co. SCTP Straight Shooters**, (*pictured above at practice on a Tuesday evening*) have started their competition season with their first shoots completed. This year there are 17 student athletes so far from multiple schools in our county and beyond. We also have home-schooled athletes as part of our team, and 2 students from just over the border in Indiana as there are no SCTP teams in their area. We have 5 certified adult coaches.

On April 17 they traveled to the **John A. Halter Olympic Shooting Center** in Hillsdale to compete in the annual SCTP Trap season opener in the Southwest Conference of the Michigan Scholastic Clay target Program (SCTP). The team took 10 student athletes to this event and one of the team members, **Jovey LaRoy**, took the High Intermediate Advanced top score to win a medal. She was elated.

Their next competition was at Mason Michigan April 24 for the brand new **Spring Fling** youth shoot hosted by the **Michigan Trapshooting Association** (MTA). This shoot invited student athletes from all youth trap sports programs, including SCTP, AIM, and the High School Clay Target League, in which both Constantine and Vicksburg High Schools participate. Vicksburg HS also sent a squad to this fun shoot. Results are pending as of this writing.

Then from May though July the team has several more travelling competitions, including the SW MI SCTP Conference Championship, Howard TWP Conservation Club youth shoot, the SCTP State Championship, the AIM State Championship, and the season culminates in the SCTP National Trap Championships held for 2 days in Ohio. The team has attended this shoot for the past 4 years.

Although we write grants to the **NRA Foundation** and **MidwayUSA Foundation** to help with costs for this program, there just isn't enough this year. Therefore, to help defray the cost of attending the Nationals in July, our team is holding a "*Pull-4-Pledges" Fun-Raiser* on the afternoon of **May 16.** This fund raising opportunity consists of an afternoon of trap shooting 2-rounds of trap (50 targets) by the youth team after obtaining "sponsors". The sponsors will pledge a certain amount "per target hit" of the 50 targets during the competition, or they can pledge a flat fee. The team is looking to raise up to \$1000 to help cover the cost of entry fees of \$76/athlete for 15-17 athletes as we showcase our team. Families and friends are invited to attend the match and cheer on our trap athletes. If you wish to donate towards this cause, please contact **Coach York at 269-483-6803**.
