First MUCC Meeting from 1937

Michigan United Conservation Clubs (MUCC) has been around a long time. Our Club is affiliated with them and therefore all our club members are also members of MUCC. Michigan United Conservation Clubs is the largest statewide conservation organization in the nation. Founded in 1937, their mission is to unite citizens to conserve, protect and enhance Michigan's natural resources and outdoor heritage. This mission drives everything MUCC does as an organization. Amy Trotter is the current Executive Director and sent the following in an email to their board of directors, including Allen Kasdorf, our MUCC Club Representative. This is in regard to finding the first meeting minutes of November 9, 1937.

In honor of our 83rd anniversary, the original minutes from the first convening of Michigan United Conservation Clubs in 1937 were located and we thought that we should share some items within them.

It is a fun read and there are some common themes still relevant today, such as commercial fishing concerns, worry about treating the UP unjustly, a donation from the "American Sportsmen and Motorboat Show", and the debate over using the term "sportsmen" vs. "conservation". They urged the clubs to not let small petty grievances interfere with the proper function of the organization and they debated the role of the individual members (5 cent per person dues and clubs were capped at \$10 per club).

It is amazing that this organization has stayed so truly in touch with its founding members, while still being able to tackle the challenges of 2020. I have a quote on my desktop screen, "A smooth sea never made a skilled sailor". I'm proud to lead this organization into a new decade, and so glad you are all "in the boat" with me.

Winter Trap League Jan 10 to March 14

This year's **Winter Trap League** will run from 1/10/21 to 3/14/21. It will be **SIN-GLES ONLY** with the "**OPTION to REGISTER**" your targets as a **Big 50** each week, <u>if enough people are interested.</u> We need 3 people to hold a registered event. It will be a 10-week league with 10 of the weeks scores to count; 50 targets (2 rounds) each week. Shoot can be modified if agreed upon by participants. This, of course, is all dependent on any lockdowns or prohibitions on gatherings.

Both registered and non-registered shooters may shoot the league and may even shoot on the same squads. Plus open Trap will continue concurrently with these events. We will need at least 3 shooters to shoot registered for the Big 50 to count that week. And you don't have to shoot registered every week. But this must be decided by the shooter before shooting that week, but it's a good way to get your ATA targets in. Youth shooters are also very welcome to participate!

The appropriate reduced fees will apply to those wishing to register their targets with the ATA. The cost will be \$20 for the league pot of money, plus each week's shoot fees (targets), and the ATA & MTA reduced daily fees *if shooting registered for that week*. Reduced fees are half of normal daily & MTA target assessment fees. We have to get approval upfront from the ATA if shooting Big 50's, so let me know if you want to participate.
