

ST. JOSEPH COUNTY CONSERVATION & SPORTSMAN CLUB SHOTGUN RANGE PLAN DURING THE COVID-19 EXECUTIVE ORDER ALLOWING OUTDOOR ACTIVITY

- All customers and volunteer workers must remain 6 feet apart from each other if they do not reside in the same household.
- Indoor accommodations available for lounging, seating, or other activities, such as clubhouses, may be limited in capacity. Therefore reference the most recent MI Dept. of Health rules. The outdoor Pavilion is available for use. Restrooms are available. Ladies Restroom access may be through the building side door. Staff may work out of clubhouse access windows with proper distancing as required.
- Range registration and fees may be handled through building access windows. Personal firearms, cases, and other gear from home may be brought into the clubhouse if clubhouse is open. Masks should be worn while indoors.
- Food may be allowed to be consumed if in compliance with current MI Dept. of Health rules. Club kitchen may be closed with the exception for ATA Shoots where Take-Out may be allowed through access window(s), if needed.
- Provide or require volunteer workers personal protective equipment such as gloves, goggles, face shields, and face masks, as appropriate, for the *work being performed*. MASKS ARE REQUIRED INDOORS PER HEALTH DEPT*.
- Limit the sharing of tools and equipment to the maximum extent possible and ensure frequent and thorough cleaning of tools, equipment, and frequently touched surfaces, especially including restrooms.
